Discussion

Commissioner Koperwhats brought attention to the cost of Stateside Affairs. Deborah Hurley, Executive Director indicated that the firm is being paid for the following service: production of new website design, branding work that includes logo design, letterhead, envelopes and business cards for the staff. In addition, they provide quarterly newsletters and have provided substantial press. Chairman N. Sanchez further expressed that we have a nonprofit that exists for the Housing Authority and there will be a need to utilize their services for grant writing purposes. Commissioner Koperwhats asked about the heating pipes. Both Chairman N. Sanchez and Executive Director, Deborah Hurley indicated that a committee will be formed shortly. Vice Chairman, Barry Telesnick inquired about using Cars Unlimited for gas. Deborah Hurley, Executive Director mentioned that we are now going to begin using the Mobile Station in Metuchen that will allow us to invoice the station rather than using the credit card which incurs fees. Attorney Terrence Corriston, indicated that we need to monitor the spending, as we may need to implement a bid process.

Sanchez expressed appreciation and looks forward to the next update from Commissioner Koperwhats.

Executive Director Deborah Hurley presented the following update:

- b.) Unit 9A renovation work from the fire has been completed.
- c.) The Dept. of Labor entered into a partnership with the Edison Housing Authority to produce scheduled Job Fairs and Resume Writing Sessions for the year, 2019.
- d.) Redesign of website and content has been completed. There will be ongoing content updates.
- e.) A recommendation was made to host a dedication ceremony in honor of the former Housing Authority Commissioner Frank Mistretta that would include his family.
