Discussion

Commissioner Mazauskas questioned bills for Polcari and the pension. Deborah Hurley, Executive Director explained that Polcari's bill reflected two bills and the next bill would be adjusted and the pension was a lump sum payment that would bring the Exec. Director's pension payment current. Commissioner Ray Koperwhats inquired about the extermination bill. Deborah Hurley, Executive Director indicated that Robert Holmes Gardens has experienced a series of bedbug issues in several units. In addition, families are being held accountable to maintain their homes. Commissioner Koperwhats asked what LWD represented. Attorney Terrence Corriston indicated that LWD represented the Labor Workforce Development. Commissioner Koperwhats inquired about Standard Waste. Executive Deborah Hurley indicated that their contract will not be ready for review until the end of the year.

Old Business:

i. Condo Unit(s) Update:

Chairman Carlos N. Sanchez requested to have Deborah Hurley, Executive Director provide an overview of the memorandum that was distributed to the commissioners about the two condo units.

Deborah Hurley, Executive Director assessed that the Edison Housing Authority will need to move towards eviction. However, in order to prevent the two families from becoming homeless, efforts are being made to ensure the families are able to secure another place within a determined period of time. Discussion ensued about the cost and expense of the units. It was determined that once the families moved out of the units, we will work with the nonprofit to identify two families that can afford the units.

- ii. Commissioner Mazauskas asked about the status of the Ceremony for Former Commissioner Frank Mistretta. Executive Director, Deborah Hurley indicated that plans have not taken place to date.
- Commissioner Koperwhats indicated that the dumpster covers at Robert Holmes Gardens are in poor condition and wanted to know about the possibility of having them replaced. Executive Director, Deborah Hurley indicated that she would work with the maintenance team to have Standard Waste provide dumpsters with new covers.
- iv. Deborah Hurley, Executive Director shared with the commissioners that efforts were made to remove two vehicles that were broken down. One of the cars finally removed from the property, appeared to have been abandoned for several years. Both cars belonged to families living at Robert Holmes Gardens.

New Business:

Deborah Hurley, Executive Director presented the following:

- a.) A partnership has been formed between the Edison Housing Authority and the Department of Labor. On March 28th a Resume Writing Session will take place at Robert Holmes Gardens and a Work Resource Day will take place on April 10th at Robert Holmes Gardens and on April 17th at Julius Engel Gardens.
- b.) CBDG grant was submitted to renovate the basketball court and a proposal was submitted to the Department of Agriculture to be a host site for a summer lunch program for children ages 5yrs to 17yrs old who live at the Edison Housing Authority.
- c.) Chairman Carlos N. Sanchez inquired about the status of the playground. Deborah Hurley, Executive Director indicated that she recently was in touch with the representative about the status of the equipment, delivery and installation. Presently, the crew is waiting for a consecutive week of good weather to begin installation. Once the installation begins, it will take a month to complete and a ribbon cutting ceremony would take place.

Public

Brenda Thomas, B2 Willard Dunham Drive, Edison, NJ, is unable to move her trash because of medical conditions. She wanted to know what should she do and how will it affect other families who are unable to move their trashcans. After a series of discussions it was determined that the Public Housing Manger at Julius Engel Gardens would monitor the situation to ensure that families assist in aiding families who need the assistance.
