REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR COMPUTER MAINTENANCE AND CYBER SECURITY SERVICES FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF EDISON HOUSING AUTHORITY

The Housing Authority of the Township of Edison, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority"), is soliciting proposals from qualified firms to provide Computer and Cyber Security Maintenance Services for a two-year term beginning November 30, 2025, and ending December 1, 2027.

The Authority seeks an experienced computer and cybersecurity consulting firm to monitor, maintain, and safeguard its technology systems to ensure minimal interruptions in service and optimal performance. The Authority currently operates nine (9) computer workstations connected to a Dell server located at the Robert E. Holmes Gardens main office. The server is approximately six years old, and all workstations are less than four years old.

Computers are utilized across both Robert E. Holmes Gardens and Julius C. Engel Gardens property sites, supporting a staff of nine (9) end-users. The Authority utilizes PHA-Web Software Corporation as its housing management platform, which assists in managing operations for approximately 394 public housing residents and 320+ Section 8 voucher holders.

The contract for services will specifically include the following:

Scope of Services

The selected contractor will provide comprehensive computer maintenance and cybersecurity services, including but not limited to:

- 1. Conducting a full assessment of the current computer system and recommending improvements.
- 2. Developing and implementing a reliable system backup protocol.
- 3. Preparing a usage manual in coordination with Authority staff.
- 4. Tracking, diagnosing, and resolving daily technical issues.
- 5. Coordinating with PHA-Web Software and other relevant vendors as needed.
- 6. Installing and managing system and software updates.
- 7. Ensuring compliance with cybersecurity regulations and policies as required by the **New Jersey Joint Insurance Fund (JIF)**.
- 8. Conducting quarterly onsite reviews with Authority staff to ensure cybersecurity measures are maintained and optimized.

All services required for Computer and Cyber Security Maintenance can be requested by emailing Camalbert@edisonha.org. Sealed proposals must be submitted by 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 13, 2025 at the Authority offices located at 14 Rev. Samuel Carpenter Blvd. Edison, NJ 08820. The Authority is an equal opportunity employer and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age or handicap status in the employment or procurement of services. Offerors are required to

comply with NJAC 17:27. The Authority reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.

The proposal is being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with NJSA 19:44A-20.4.

An original and one (1) copy of the proposal must be submitted no later than Thursday, November 13, 2025 at 11:00 a.m. The proposal should include a detailed background of the company and all appropriate information, detailing the company's ability to do business in the State of New Jersey and include the following documents under Exhibit A, which must accompany this proposal.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Except with respect to affectional or sexual orientation and gender identity or expression, the contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that such applicants are recruited and employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Such action shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will send to each labor union or representative or workers with which it has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer advising the labor union or workers' representative of the contractor's commitments under this act and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to employ minority and women workers consistent with the applicable county employment goals established in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2, or a binding determination of the applicable county employment goals determined by the Division, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to inform in writing its appropriate recruitment agencies including, but not limited to, employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to revise any of its testing procedures, if necessary, to assure that all personnel testing conforms with the principles of job-related testing, as established by the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey and as established by applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

In conforming with the applicable employment goals, the contractor or subcontractor agrees to review all procedures relating to transfer, upgrading, downgrading and layoff to ensure that all such actions are taken without regard to age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, consistent with the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey, and applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

The contractor shall submit to the public agency, after notification of award but prior to execution of a goods and services contract, one of the following three documents:

Letter of Federal Affirmative Action Plan Approval

Certificate of Employee Information Report

Employee Information Report Form AA302

The contractor and its subcontractors shall furnish such reports or other documents to the Div. of Contract Compliance & EEO as may be requested by the office from time to time in order to carry out the purposes of these regulations, and public agencies shall furnish such information as may be requested by the Div. of Contract Compliance & EEO for conducting a compliance investigation pursuant to Subchapter 10 of the Administrative Code at N.J.A.C. 17:27.
